



## **Step 2 Coronavirus Conditions for Visiting Clubs**

### **NHS Track and Trace**

Visiting clubs are required to provide a list of those attending

### **Arrival and departure**

Visiting Bowlers are requested to arrive at Lindfield BC dressed to play. Shoes must be changed using the outside benches. Entry to the clubhouse is not permitted except for to use of the toilets. Dress code is Greys unless advised otherwise.

### **Toilets**

Toilets are accessed through the Changing Room Doors: Gentlemen to the Left of the Clubhouse, Ladies to the right of The Clubhouse.

**Only 1 person is allowed in each toilet area at a time**

**Important Rule: for using the toilets:**

**Sanitise your hands before entering and wear a mask.**

**Sanitise anything you have touched and your hands before you leave the clubhouse**

### **Drinking Water**

Use of the kitchen area is not permitted. Players should bring their own water bottle either labelled with their name or are distinguishable.

### **Bar**

The Government's hospitality guidelines apply for how the bar is organised. The same procedure will apply as for pubs, restaurants and takeaways. Players must be seated outside in groups of 6 or two households and orders will be taken and delivered to you while seated. Card payments are preferred.

Social distancing rules apply both before and after the match.

Visiting the bar to order drinks or for the return of empty glasses is not allowed.

The bar will be open when bar staff have arranged to be present.

### **Spectators**

Spectators are not allowed except on public land. As LBC is on public land spectators are allowed provided they adhere to the gathering limits of group of six or two households and social distancing. 6 Spectators are only allowed at organized match times (not organised roll-ups) and must sit on the benches on the non-playing side of the green. Spectators should sign in using the NHS app and scan the OCR displayed on the Clubhouse.

### **Equipment**

Players should avoid using shared equipment whenever possible. Only use and touch your own woods, measure and spray chalk.

Only the Home lead will place the mats

It is recommended that each lead uses a different coloured jack.

Only the Home Number 2 will use the pushers

Only the Home skip will use the scoreboard
